In the Times Higher Education World University Rankings for 2025, released in 2024,

Australia has

6 universities in the world's top 100

10 universities in the world's top 200

33 universities in the world's top 500

9 universities outside the world's top 500

UK has

12 universities in the world's top 100

24 universities in the world's top 200

51 universities in the world's top 500

90 universities outside the world's top 500

USA has

37 universities in the world's top 100

53 universities in the world's top 200

102 universities in the world's top 500

2,526 (four-year) universities outside the world's top 500 (another 1,268 two-year universities are beyond the scope of this analysis).

Measures of numbers and proportions of universities in the world rankings are important. But measures of numbers and proportions of students in world ranked universities may provide more insight.

Student Numbers

In Australia

26% of students are at universities in the world's top 100

36% of students are at universities in the world's top 200

90% of students are at universities in the world's top 500

10% of students are at universities outside the world's top 500


In UK


15% of students are at universities in the world's top 100

26% of students are at universities in the world's top 200

44% of students are at universities in the world's top 500


56% of students are at universities outside the world's top 500





In USA

9% of students are at universities in the world's top 100
13% of students are at universities in the world's top 200
23% of students are at universities in the world's top 500
77% of students are at universities outside the world's top 500

Australia: The Australian Department of Education provides a list for 2023 of Australia's 42 universities, including Australia's 37 public universities plus 5 private universities. Student enrolment in the 42 universities aggregated to 1.462 million.

Student enrolment in the 33 universities in the world's top 500 aggregated to 1.312 million, 89.7% of the total enrolment.

Student enrolment in the 10 universities in the world's top 200 aggregated to 0.532 million, 36.4% of the total enrolment.

Student enrolment in the 6 universities in the world's top 100 aggregated to 0.382 million, 26.2% of the total enrolment.

The UK Higher Education Statistics Agency provides a list for 2022/23 of higher education providers and their student enrolment, aggregating to 2.937 million in the 260 higher education providers, including 2.757 million students in the 141 universities.

Student enrolment in the 51 universities in the world's top 500 aggregated to 1.212 million, 44.0% of the total enrolment in universities.

Student enrolment in the 24 universities in the world's top 200 aggregated to 0.730 million, 26.5% of the total enrolment in universities.

Student enrolment in the 12 universities in the world's top 100 aggregated to 0.407 million, 14.8% of the total enrolment in universities.

Student populations in the 102 universities in the world's top 500 aggregated to 3.278 million, 23.5% of the total student population.

Student populations in the 53 universities in the world's top 200 aggregated to 1.879 million, 13.4% of the total student population.

Student populations in the 37 universities in the world's top 100 aggregated to 1.290 million, 9.2% of the total student population.

(Another 4.683 million students in 1,268 two year institutions in USA are beyond this analysis.)
